We seek candidates who have strong teaching skills in both online and on-campus environments and an interest in curriculum development, who are eager to develop their research profile, and who are seeking a collegial approach to working with colleagues. Candidates are asked to demonstrate their skill and experience in classroom and online post-secondary teaching and curriculum development and should also be prepared to share their records of research and scholarship, and university service. Preference will be given to those candidates who hold a relevant doctoral degree from a reputable institution.
