# REGULATIONS

REMINDER: Grades reported should include either the final grades for applicable 3000 level courses finished to date, or the mid-term results for applicable 3000 level courses being completed during this school year.

Advanced placement/4000 level course, etc. may be used in place of the appropriate 3000 level course to calculate the average for scholarship offers, if it gives the student the best possible advantage.

- The average used for early offers is based on the 10 credits required for admission to Memorial University of Newfoundland
- Averages are calculated by factoring the two credit courses (i.e. x 2) and dividing by 10 credits.
- A minimum of 900 points are needed to achieve the required minimum average of 90%
